






We put pictures on our school Twitter account, to share our learning with our grown ups at home.








We became map readers when we successfully used a map of our school in groups to find the letters that spelt out the name of our new topic.









The children in Year 2 recapped the 4 countries of the United Kingdom before going on to learn the names of the 7 continents and 5 Oceans.
