Ava and her mum are arriving at school.

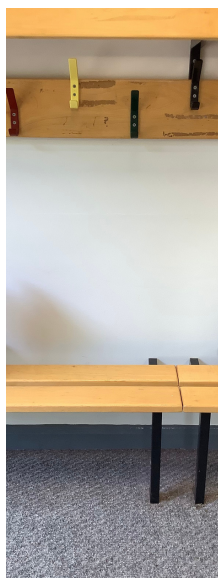
"Good Morning!" says the teacher.

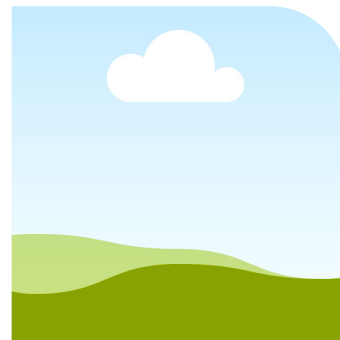
